10.30am – 2pm, Peterchurch

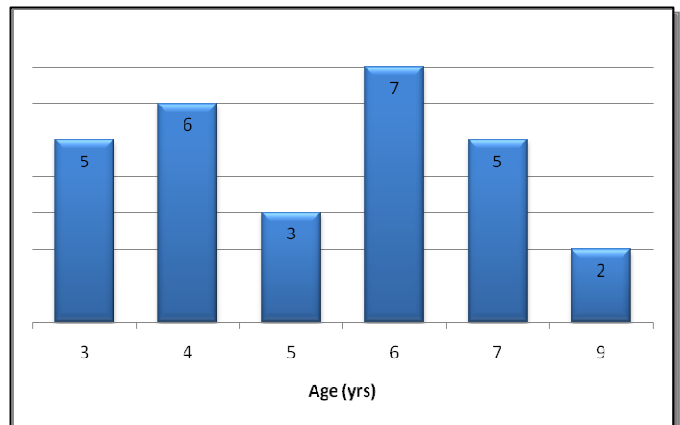

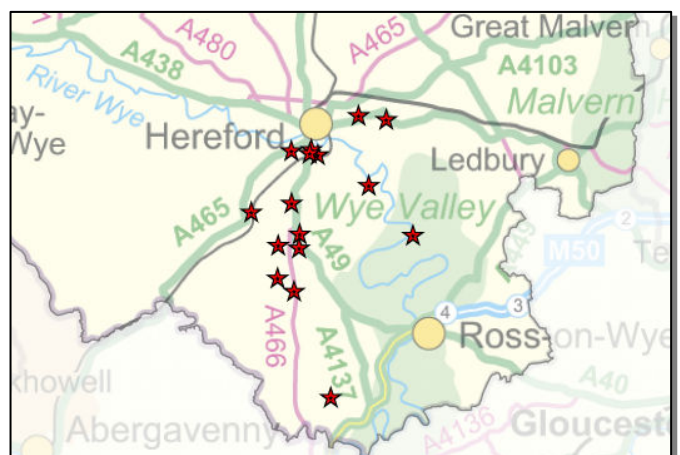
16 families attended, represented by:
