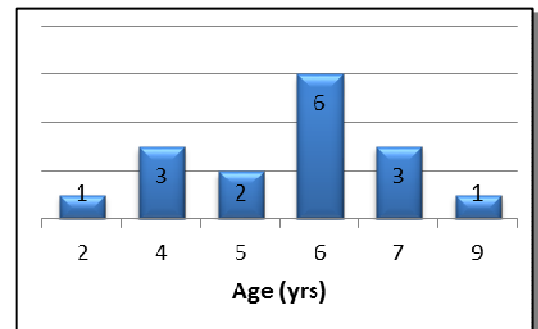


## DAYS OUT WITH DAD

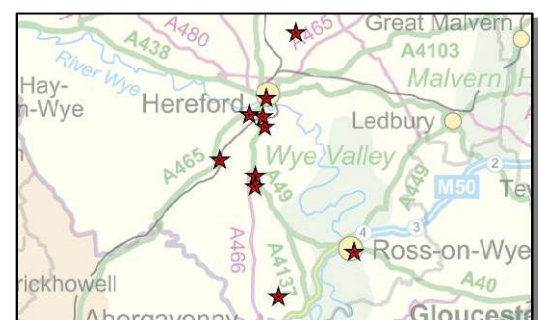
10 families attended, represented by:
